

# **MOUNTING, USE AND CARE**

## **"BigMouth CatchCounter"**



- Tools required- tape measure, straitedge or square, pencil or sharpie type marker, drill/with a ¼" bit, jig or sabre saw.
- 1. Most folks mount catchcounter to a bucket or cooler lid. A 48 qt. standard cooler is popular but charter boats can use large 120 qt. coolers. In any case the first consideration is how and where your cooler will sit in your boat. You will want to mount CatchCounter to be an easy reach for the majority of people on board. Bucket mounted units have no special considerations as they are always centered on the bucket lid.
- Most but not all CatchCounters are center mounted –forward facing, on the cooler top.
- Bucket Mounting is easy. Usually there is a center indent in the bucket lid and you can use that to extend 2 lines @ 90 degrees to the edge of the lid. Using your lines as a guide, set the counter dead-center on the lid. With a sharp marker trace around the bottom to leave a clean circle on the lid
- Use your ¼" bit and drill a starter hole somewhere inside the circle close to the line.
- With a jig or sabre saw CAREFULLY cut the line and the circle out so BigMouth fits snugly in the hole.
- To finish, mark the 2 mounting holes and drill out with a ¼" bit.
- You can secure the counter with short bolts and nuts or wing nuts. 2 sets are required.
- Cooler mounting. With a measure and square, mark a 8" cross and centerline on the lid where you want the counter to be. Carefully set the counter on that cross so it is dead-center.
- With a sharp marker trace around the base of the counter to leave a good line on the lid.
- Drill inside the circle, close to the edge, a ¼" starter hole.
- With a jig or sabre saw CAREFULLY cut the circle out.
- Set your counter in the hole, rotate to the precise spot you want it to face, and mark the 2 mounting hole locations on the lid.
- Remove the counter , drill the 2 holes with a ¼"bit.
- Set the counter back on the lid and attach with the correct length bolts washers and nuts.

## **USE AND CARE**

- CatchCounter is made of PVC and Aluminium and can take the weather.
- Clean with mild soap and water and a cloth.
- Keep counting mechanism out of direct contact with water. Avoid direct hose spray. Rinse with clean water and dry with a clean cloth.
